## The Countdown to Swim Season Has Begun!

**T**umlinson Pool opens for the season on Monday, May 1 from 4:30-8:00pm (see schedule below, posted at the pools, or online at [www.blockhousemud.com](http://www.blockhousemud.com)). In order to use the Block House pools, tags are required, and they must be renewed every year. **Watch the MUD website, Facebook page, Twitter, eBlasts, and electronic sign by the Walker House for information about your new 2019 tags.** Each household may bring up to five guests to the pool at a time at no charge.

From June 1 through August 14, the MUD Board has authorized Tumlinson Pool to open at 9:00am on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays - an hour earlier than years past for residents to take advantage of the morning hours!

Residents still have the opportunity to join the TIDAL WAVES SWIM TEAM! The registration date earlier this month was rained out. If you are interested in learning more and signing up, watch for details on the rescheduled registration date.

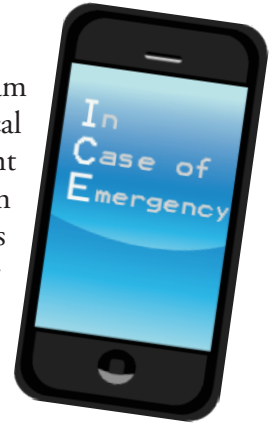

## Safety Corner: ICE Your Phone!

**ICE** (i.e. In Case of Emergency) is a program that enables first responders and medical personnel to contact the next of kin after an incident using the injured party's mobile phone. The program was conceived in the mid-2000s and encourages individuals to enter emergency contacts in their mobile phone's address book under "ICE."

If you were in an incident and could not communicate with medical personnel:

- How would medical personnel know whom to contact to gather information about you?
- How would medical personnel know if you have existing medical conditions that could impact proposed treatment(s)?



### iPhone

The iPhone has this built in and also allows for blood type, meds, etc. It's accessible to anybody without needing the phone's access codes. Look for the 'Health' app that is pre-installed (white background with a red heart).

### Samsung

The Samsung Galaxy Phones also have this feature. The lock screen contains an "emergency call" option, and it allows first responders to call anyone you have selected as ICE in your address book. You can also fill out your medical details and have them available for emergency personnel.

There are apps, such as QuickICE, available for other Android phones to utilize this program. Thinking about ways to be prepared for an emergency is always a smart idea!
